Структура и содержание дисциплины

1. Цели и задачи дисциплины, ее место в учебном процессе

Цели изучения дисциплины — формирование навыков языковой, речевой и межкультурной компетенции студентов в пределах изучаемой тематики, обучение культуре иноязычного устного и письменного общения, формирование профессиональных умений и навыков студентов.

Задачи изучения дисциплины — формирование умений студентов владеть 4 видами устной и письменной речевой деятельности, усовершенствование практических навыков перевода текстов разных типов и стилей, постоянное развитие навыков ситуативного общения, аудирование тематических текстов и выполнение творческих работ.

2. Место дисциплины в структуре ООП ВО

Дисциплина относится к циклу обязательных профессиональных дисциплин.

Необходимыми условиями для освоения дисциплины являются: знания – культуре и традициях стран изучаемого языка; о правилах речевого этикета; о артикуляции звуков специфике и интонации, акцентуации нейтральной речи в изучаемом языке; о дифференциации лексики по сферам применения (бытовая, терминологическая, общенаучная, официальная и др.); свободных и устойчивых словосочетаниях, фразеологических единицах; об основных способах словообразования; умения – построить диалогическую и монологическую речь с использованием наиболее употребительных и простых лексико-грамматических средств относительно коммуникативных ситуациях; навыки – публичной речи (устное сообщение); диалогической и монологической речь в сфере бытовой коммуникации; чтения и перевода несложных текстов.

Содержание дисциплины является продолжением содержания дисциплин: «Введение в специальность», «Теория межкультурной коммуникации» и служит основой для изучения следующих дисциплин: «Лингвострановедение стран второго иностранного языка», «Методы перевода и анализ художественного текста».
